The specific topics addressed by the paper should be indicated.

The abstract must be submitted via the link on the web site. Other methods including hard copy, email or fax submissions will not be accepted.

Abstracts must be received before August 31, 2013.

Note that authors of accepted papers are expected to attend the Symposium.

PUBLICATIONS

The printed Symposium proceedings will contain the one-page abstracts of all papers accepted by the Scientific Committee. The full version will be included on a CD-ROM enclosed with the proceedings, and will be available at the beginning of the Symposium.
